Mr. Abhaya Parida, B.Ed, M.A, M.Phil is working as co-coordinator for the programme. Noted academicians and faculty members are invited from RIE, NCERT, and Colleges of Utkal University and other universities as a guest faculty.

**MODE:** The Course is offered under the Distance mode. CHOICE BASED CREDIT SEMESTER (CBCS) is followed. One Personal Contact Program (classes) of 7 to 10 days duration shall be held for each semester covering theory and project component as per syllabi. Students can meet teachers for guidance, counselling and doubt clearance.

### SELECTION PROCESS

- First come first serve basis
- All eligible SC/ST student shall be admitted provided they take admission within due date.

### RESERVATION

- 22.50% of seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Tribe Students.
- 16.25% of seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Caste students. (*Vide Notification Government of Odisha Department of Higher Education No. 11710 / HE: Bhubaneswar, the 1st June, 2015. HE-FE-III-Admn.-64/14*)
- Reservation policy of PG Council, Utkal University shall be applicable.
- All reserved category students have to full fill admission criteria and also take admission in due date.

### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

- A set of self-attested copies of mark sheets and certificates from 10<sup>th</sup> class onwards along with originals are required for verification.
- Original C.L.C. and Migration Certificate (for the Candidates from other than Utkal University).
- Caste certificate for SC & ST candidates.
- Each candidate is required to carry a photo identity card (Aadhar Card/Driving license / PAN Card / Voter's I Card or Identity card issued by employer / educational institute etc.) for the online test for Management and Computer Science Programme.
