Resolved that the new Syllabus (approved by BOS on 18.10. 2012) of M.Phil programme in Public Administration in Semester System from the session 2013-14 is approved.

Further resolved that M.Phil Syllabus of any Department which has not come under Semester System needs to switchover to semester system w.e.f. January, 2013 and the Controller Examinations may ensure that such change is affected in all Post Graduate Departments of University.

Item No. 13 To consider and approve the MDS regulation and Syllabus in the specialties of " Prosthodontic Crown and Bridge " and Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics " with an intake capacity of 02 seats each from the academic session 2013- 2014 as recommended by Board of Studies at its meeting on 14.12. 2012 (Annexure )

Resolved that the MDS regulation and Syllabus in the specialties of " Prosthodontics and Crown and Bridge " and Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics " with an intake capacity of 02 (Two) seats each from the academic session 2013-14 as recommended by Board of Studies at its meeting held on 14.12. 2012 is approved.

Item No. 14 To consider and approve the revised regulation of M. Tech. IT to be effective from 2011-12 as per recommendation of Board of Studies at its meeting held on 18.10. 2011 (Annexure)

Resolved that the revised regulation of M.Tech. IT to be effective from 2011- 2012 as per recommendation of Board of Studies at its meeting held on 18,10, 2011 is approved.

Item No. 15 To consider and approve the modification of Ph.D regulation under C.S No. 1351- Clause- 12.1 as recommended by the University Research Committee at its meeting held on 21.11. 2012 and 28.12. 2012 as endorsed by the Controller of Examinations on 13.02. 2013 (Annexure).

15.1 The decision of the University Research Committee held on 21.11. 2012 under Item No. 18 regarding publication of the scholar is considered and resolved that the resolution under Item No. 11 be followed.

15.2 Considered the University Research Committee decision vide Item No. 1 of its meeting held on 28.12. 2012 regarding course work is considered and resolved that the Ph.D scholars who have already been registered or submitted their thesis or who have already been awarded Ph.D being registered after June, 2009 may do course work as it is mandatory as per UGC regulation, 2009. Further resolved that such course work shall be offered by the Post Graduate Departments or recognized Centers of Ph.D Research work only in 2013 & 2014. It was further clarified that such course work is mandatory only for those who are to be registered. This resolution is adopted in view of the UGC ( Minimum qualifications required for the appointment and career advancement of teachers in Universities and Institutions affiliated to it ) ( 3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment ) Regulation, 2009 ( " NET, SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Lecturers in Universities / Colleges / Institutions. Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D Degree in compliance of the " University Grants Commission ( minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D Degree ), Regulation, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET / SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions " .

15.3 Resolved that the Subject Research Committees shall be competent to draw list of approved journals for publication as required for submission of Ph.D. Thesis.

15.4 Resolved that submission of the soft copy of all Ph.D. Thesis be mandatory and such soft copies are to be received and stored digitally by the University Computer Center or the University Examination Computer Cell or the DDCE Computer Cell. No thesis be accepted without a certification to that effect. The Registrar was requested to complete the formalities of signing of MOU for the Sodha-Ganga project in the UGC depository. The following regulation of the UGC under Clause-19 be implemented in letter and spirit to prevent plagiarism.

" Clause - 19 : Following the successful completion of the evaluation process and announcements of the award of M.Phil/ Ph.D., the University shall submit a soft copy of the M.Phil, Ph.D thesis to the UGC within a period of thirty days, for hosting the same in INFLIBNET, accessible to all institutions / Universities ."

The Regulation Amending Committee and the University Research Committee may work out the details. The Controllors of Examinations was requested to ensure implementation of the above in tune with the UGC Regulation of 2009.

15.5 Resolved that the decision of the University Research Committee held on 28.12.2012 under Item No. 15.5 that a Professor can take four more scholars over and above the stipulated number for those who are NET/GATE qualified and who have completed Ph.D. course work under Ph.D. Regulation Clause-3.21. Following clause shall be added under Clause No. 3.2.5.  
"A Professor may accept four additional scholars to accommodate NET/GATE qualified Scholars who have completed necessary course work" under the approval of the Vice-Chancellor.

Item No.16 To consider the introduction of New Course i.e. Master in Retail Management in PPP Mod W.P. (C) No.15584/2012, dated 14.02.2013.  
Considered the introduction of New Course i.e. Master in Retail Management in PPP Mod Department of P.M. & I.R., Utkal University, by orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa, Cuttack vide W.P.(C) No.15584/2012, dated 14.02.2013 along with the notes of Chairman Council and resolved that the Vice-Chancellor is authorized to take a favorable decision in regard.


Item No.17 Considered the proposal of waiving the requirement of Entrance Test for those who have completed M.Phil before introduction of Entrance Test for admission into M.Phil and resolved that the University Research Committee may grant such waiver in tune with the following clause of UGC Regulation Clause-9.1 : All Universities, Institutions, Deemed to be Universities and Colleges/Institutions of National Importance shall admit M.Phil doctoral students through an Entrance Test conducted at the level of individual University, Institution, Deemed to be University, College/Institution of National Importance. The University may decide separate terms and conditions for those who qualify UGC/CSIR/JRF Examination/SLET/GATE/teacher fellowship holder or holder of M.Phil Programme for Ph.D. Entrance Test. Similar approach may be adopted in the case of Entrance Test for M.Phil Programme".

The Proposal for considering the cases of students admitted under lateral entry in B.B.(Auto) College in ETC course is not accepted.


Prof. S.K. Das, Controller of Examinations offered a vote of thanks to the Chair and others present. The Vice-Chancellor, Chairman of the Academic Council adjourned the meeting to a date to be notified later.
